3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Fairness for 9/115 Families Act".

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1 **SEC. 2. APPROPRIATIONS.** (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 404(d)(4)(C) of the Jus-2 tice for United States Victims of State Sponsored Ter-3 rorism Act (34 U.S.C. 20144(d)(4)(C)) is amended by 4 adding at the end the following: 5 6 "(iv) AUTHORIZATION.— 7 "(I) IN GENERAL.—The Special Master shall authorize lump sum 8 9 catch-up payments in amounts equal to the amounts described in sub-10 11 clauses (I), (II), and (III) of clause 12 (iii). 13 "(II) APPROPRIATIONS.— "(aa) IN GENERAL.—There 14 15 are authorized to be appropriated 16 and there are appropriated to the 17 Fund such sums as are necessary 18 to carry out this clause, to re-19 main available until expended. 20 "(bb) LIMITATION.-21 Amounts appropriated pursuant 22 to item (aa) may not be used for 23 a purpose other than to make 24 lump sum catch-up payments 25 under this clause.".

 the amendments made by subsection (a) are des ignated as an emergency requirement pursuant to
 section 4(g) of the Statutory Pay-As-You-Go Act of
 2010 (2 U.S.C. 933(g)).

8 are designated as an emergency requirement pursu9 ant to subsections (a) and (b) of section 4001 of S.
10 Con. Res. 14 (117th Congress), the concurrent reso11 lution on the budget for fiscal year 2022.

(c) RESCISSION.—Of the unobligated balances of
amounts made available under the heading "Small Business Administration—Business Loans Program Account,
CARES Act", for carrying out paragraphs (36) and (37)
of section 7(a) of the Small Business Act (15 U.S.C.
636(a)), \$2,982,000,000 are hereby rescinded.
